- Rules** Current N.R.A. High Power Rifle rules will govern.
- Entries** Individuals: Entries in individual events will be made using the enclosed Registration form, accompanied by check or money order. Circle the Number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicated Your current N.R.A. classification and N.R.A. member number. Mail entries with correct fees to:

Advanced entries must be received no later than 7/8/2010.

Entries Limited	Entries are limited to 100 competitors. Post entries will be accepted up to the stated limit of the range, provided such entries will not require squadding of extra relays.
Fees	Individual entry fee will be \$80.00 for two days or \$60.00 for one day. Entry fees include \$9.00 to N.R.A. for Regional match and \$15.00 per day for N.R.A. Whittington Center for range fee. The Whittington Center has raised the range fees from \$10.00 to \$15.00 per day (thus the increase in entry fees).
Souvenir Pins	Will be given to each individual who competes.
Squadding	All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at 7:00 AM each day at the stat office. A competitor who fails to pick up his squadding ticket will only be squadded to fill up vacancies.
Classification	The N.R.A. Long Range classification system will be used in all matches. Any individual or team may elect, before firing to compete in a higher Classification than the one in which classified. Such individual or team must fire in the higher classification throughout the entire tournament. International competitors without N.R.A. U.S.A. classification will Compete in the highest classification.
Scoring	Competitors will score; any competitor failing to perform his/her scoring Duties may be disqualified. Scoring system (b) will be used.
Target Service	Competitors will pull their own targets.
Target	N.R.A. L.R. Target will be used.
Sights	Division A iron or any as specified by match conditions. Division S and Division P will use metallic sights only.
Empty Chamber Indicators	Empty chamber indicators are required and must be used at all times, except preparation time and firing.
Division by Rifle	Division A: Any rifle Division S: Service rifle Division P: Palma rifle Division F: F Class
Rifle	Note: Individuals in Division S must fire the service rifle in all matches.
Categories	Any rifle, Service rifle (includes Reserve and National

Guard), Civilian service rifle, Palma rifle and F Class.

Course of Fire

Match 1

Any rifle/any sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 30 minute time limit.

Match 2

Any rifle/iron sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 30 minute time limit.

Match 3

Any rifle/iron sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 30 minute time limit.

Thursday, July 15, 2010 Thousand Yd. Matches.

Match 4

Any rifle/ any sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 30 minutes time limit.

Match 5.

Palma rifle/ iron sights, unlimited sighters & 20 shots for record in 30 minutes time limit.

Match 6

Santa Fe Trail Long Range Regional Grand Aggregate

An aggregate of matches 1 thru. 5 in division "A" Long Range Regional.
An aggregate of matches 1 thru 5 in division "B" Long Range Regional.
An aggregate of matches 1 thru 5 in division "C" Long Range Regional.
An aggregate of matches 1 thur 5 in division "F" Long Range Regional.

Classes

The classes are: High Master, Master, Expert, and Sharpshooter and Marksman, provided that there are sufficient entries in a class to warrant

awards.

Award disposition There must be 5 or more entries in a class for one award, 8 or more for two awards and 13 or more for three awards. If there are fewer than 5 High Masters entered, they must fire for open awards only. The High Master class may not be combined with the Master Class.

Cash will be given to each Match winner and to Individuals in each Division by Class on Wednesday and Thursday in accordance with a schedule which will be posted at the Stat Office prior to commencement of Firing.

If there is fewer than the required number of entries in a class to provide awards, they will be combined with the same class in another division. If there are still fewer than 5 entries after combining the divisions there will be NO AWARDS provided in that class and all competitors in the lower class will be moved back to their respective division in the next higher class, until there are a minimum of 5 competitors in the combined classes.

Challenge Period The Challenge period ends ½ hour after the posting of the match results

Procedure for clearing the firing line:

At no time is anyone to leave the firing line with a loaded rifle! All competitors are to be responsible for safe rifles while on the firing line. At no time should a competitor get out of position without the Empty Chamber Indicator being placed in the empty chamber and the competitor's scorekeeper verifies that fact. Penalty for breaking this rule is disqualification from the match for both the competitor and scorekeeper. Anyone that fires a shot during the preparation period will be scored a miss for the first record shot of that match. Anyone that fires a shot prior to the preparation period or any other non firing period will be disqualified from any further competition.

There will an awards ceremony 45 minutes after shooting is complete on Thursday July 15 2010.
