

U.S. Under 25 Prone Rifle National Championships

DATES: June 17th-21st, 2019

LOCATION: NRA Whittington Center, Raton, New Mexico

COMPETITOR CLASSIFICATION: This match will be conducted using the NRA High Power classification system. Any individual or team may, before firing, elect to compete in a higher classification, except High Master, than the one in which they are classified.

OPEN TO:

The National U25 Prone Rifle Championship is open to all competitors whose 25 birthday falls later than June 17th, 2019. Membership in NRA is not required but highly recommended. Competitors who are not NRA members are not eligible for National Record recognition.

CLOSING DATES:

Pre-registration is required. Entries must be received no later than June 1st. Individuals needing to cancel will receive a full refund if notification is given before June 1st, 2019.

TEAM REQUIREMENT:

Teams may enter under the following High-Power rules: 2.10, 2.11, 2.12, 2.13 and 2.18. Teams may enter under Rule 2.13.1 but will compete in the Open Team Category.

TEAM ENTRY PROCEDURE:

1. There are two NRA Under 25 Team Matches. Team Captains will be required to complete a form listing team name, organization, team classification. Team Captain's name and competitor number before leaving the entry office. Team Captains are required to turn in the completed Entry Confirmation Card to the Stat Officer before noon on June 19th.
2. Team Members Not Firing in Individual Matches: Individuals firing only on teams or acting as a non-firing Captain or Coach must register in advance using a regular entry card. Competitor numbers will be issued, and special competitor packets will be made up upon request of the individual. Captains and coaches in this category must meet the Under 25 requirements

RULES:

Current NRA Rules will govern the conduct of this championship except as modified within this program. Check the Match Director’s Bulletin for modifications of firing conditions.

OFFICIAL BULLETIN BOARD:

The Official Bulletin Board is located outside the Bald Eagles Building behind the 1000-yard line on the George Tubb Range. Preliminary Bulletins on all Matches and all Official Notices will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board. Competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to check the Board for official notices and scores. (Rule 18.11)

TARGETS:

All fired targets will remain under control of NRA.

Target Changing and Handling:

1. Competitors are required to operate targets. Failure to perform pit duties will result in disqualification from that match.
2. Disabled competitors who cannot perform this duty must furnish as adequate substitute. Substitute target pullers must be registered at the Entry Office and

approved by the match director. No pullers will be allowed for any competitor capable of performing this duty. Final decision will be the Match Director whether to allow a substitute puller.

AWARDS:

1. Cash and prizes will be awarded to winners with some given by random drawing.

SQUADDING:

1. All matches will be squadded by the Chief Statistical Officer. Check-in is required. Firing will begin at 9:00a.m. each day. Roll Call will be conducted on the firing line at 8:30a.m. each morning. After roll call those relays assigned pit duty will proceed to the pits.

FIRING TIMES:

1. Firing will begin at 9:00a.m. each day.
2. **Blow off period:** There will be a 2-minute blow off period at the beginning of your first match each day.
3. Match numbers and days on which they are fired are listed below.

Match 914 Individual Match – 800 yards – 2 Sighters and 15 for record

Match 915 Individual Match – 900 yards – 2 Sighters and 15 for record

Match 916 Individual Match – 1000 yards – 2 Sighters and 15 for record

Thursday – June 20th

Match 920 Team Match – 600 yards – Aggregate score 800-80x possible

2 Sighters / 20 record shots/team member

Match 921 Team Match – 1000 yards – Aggregate Score 800-80x possible

2 Sighters / 20 record shots/team member

Friday – June 21st

Match 917 Individual Match – 1000 yards – 2 Sighters and 20 for record

Match 918 Individual Match – 1000 yards – 2 Sighters and 20 for record

Match 919 Aggregate scores of matches 911-918 and will determine overall National Championship Winners.

TARGETS:

Targets used in this match will be **NRA MR-1FCA, LR-FCA**

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATORS (ECI): Safety is paramount! Rifles will have actions open, magazines removed, and an **ECI** inserted into the chamber at **ALL** times **except** - when on the firing line during the preparation period or during live firing. ECIs will be available for purchase at the range for \$2.00

PREPARATION PERIOD AND PROCEDURE FOR CLEARING THE LINE:

At no time is a competitor to leave the firing line with a loaded rifle! All competitors are responsible for safe rifles while on the firing line. At no time should a competitor get out of position without having first placed an **Empty Chamber Indicator** in the empty chamber of his/her rifle. This fact must be verified by the competitor's scorekeeper. The penalty for violating this rule is disqualification for both competitor and scorekeeper.

At the beginning of each relay is a **3-minute preparation period**. The ECI may be removed but **no ammunition may be loaded at this time**. Anyone who fires a shot during the preparation period will be scored a miss for the first record shot of that match. **Anyone who fires a shot prior to the preparation period or any other non-firing period will be disqualified from the competition.**

COACHING: Coaching is not allowed except in Team matches.

SCORING: Competitors will score. Individuals failing to perform the required scoring duties may be disqualified. Standard NRA scoring will be used.

CHALLENGE FEE:

Shot values may be challenged during the firing of a match. No Challenge fee.

ADMINISTRATIVE CHALLENGES:

Preliminary bulletins scores may be challenged during the posted challenge period. No fee is charged for an administrative challenge.

AWARDS CEREMONY:

The Awards will be conducted on the evening of June 20th. Time and place TBA.

AWARDS SCHEDULE: Will be posted at the match and is dependent upon participation levels in each rifle category.
